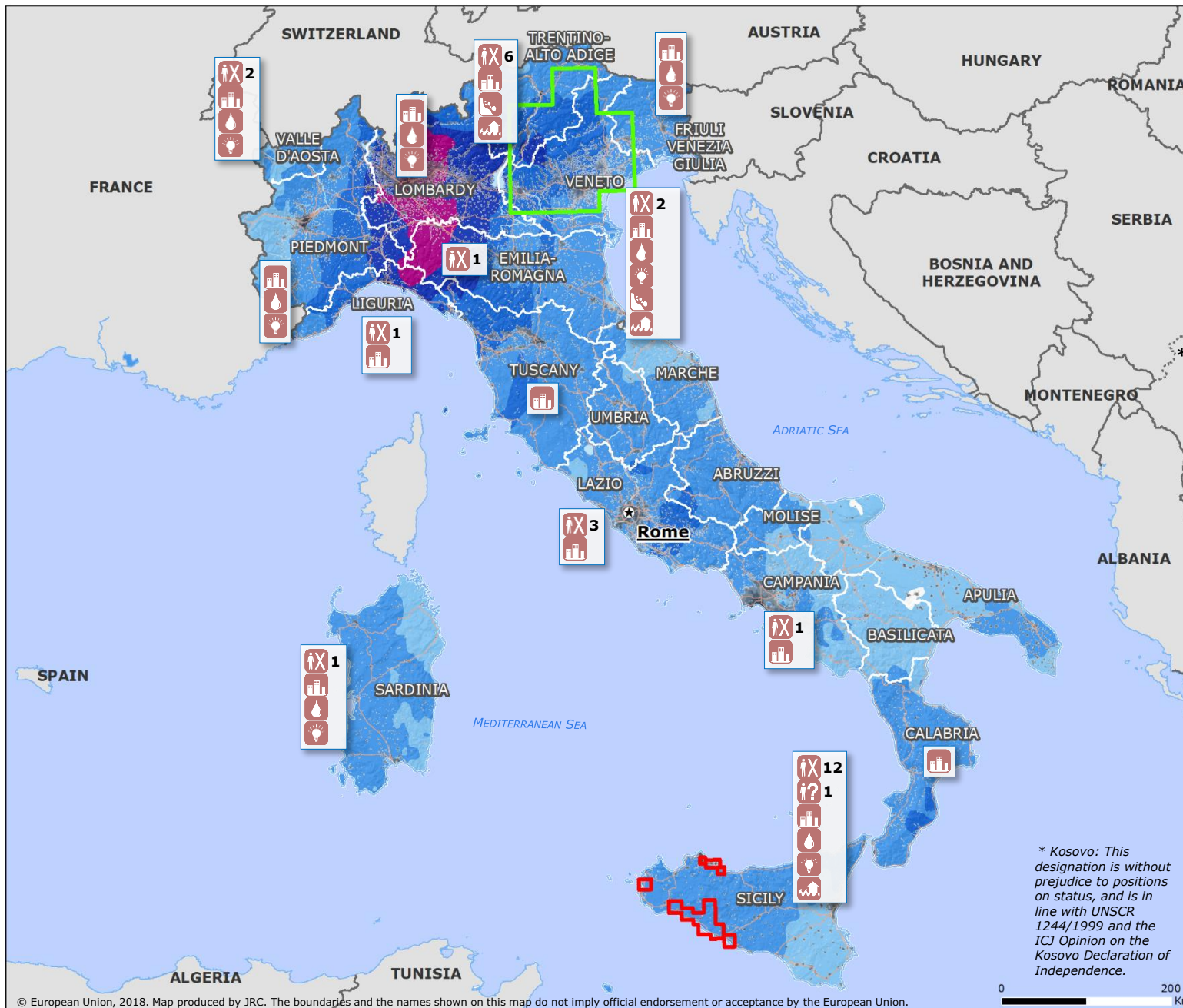


Italy | Severe Weather



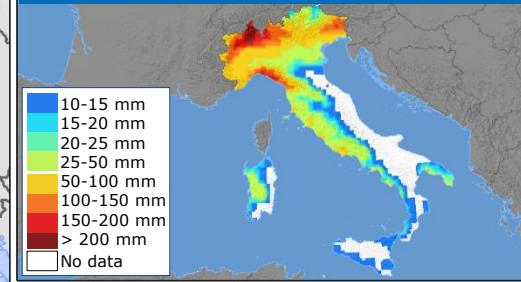
SITUATION OVERVIEW

- Starting from the 28th of October heavy rains and strong winds have repeatedly affected most of the regions of the national territory causing victims and serious damages to housing, infrastructures, agriculture and forestry. So far 29 fatalities have been confirmed in 9 different regions and one person is missing recorded in the region of Sicily, due to the severe storms.
- Floods and landslides have affected several parts of the country. Electricity and water supply disruptions as well as interruptions of the road network have been recorded in the region of Sicily, Friuli Venezia Giulia, Lombardia, Piedmont, Sardinia, Valle d'Aosta and Veneto regions.
- The Italian civil protection system is fully activated to cope with the situation. 600 municipal operational coordination centres are active throughout the entire territory, as well as 21 inter-municipal coordination centres and 4 provincial coordination centres in the provinces of Treviso, Belluno and the metropolitan areas of Venice and Palermo.
- Some limited evacuations have been performed and all response levels are operating.
