Event On 08 June 2026 at 07:37 local time, a magnitude 7.8 earthquake struck offshore Sarangani, southern Mindanao, Philippines, at a depth of approximately 55.2 km. The event has caused damage to buildings and infrastructure in the affected areas, and further impacts are expected to be identified through emergency assessment. Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping is requested to provide damage assessment emergency mapping over the most affected areas.
