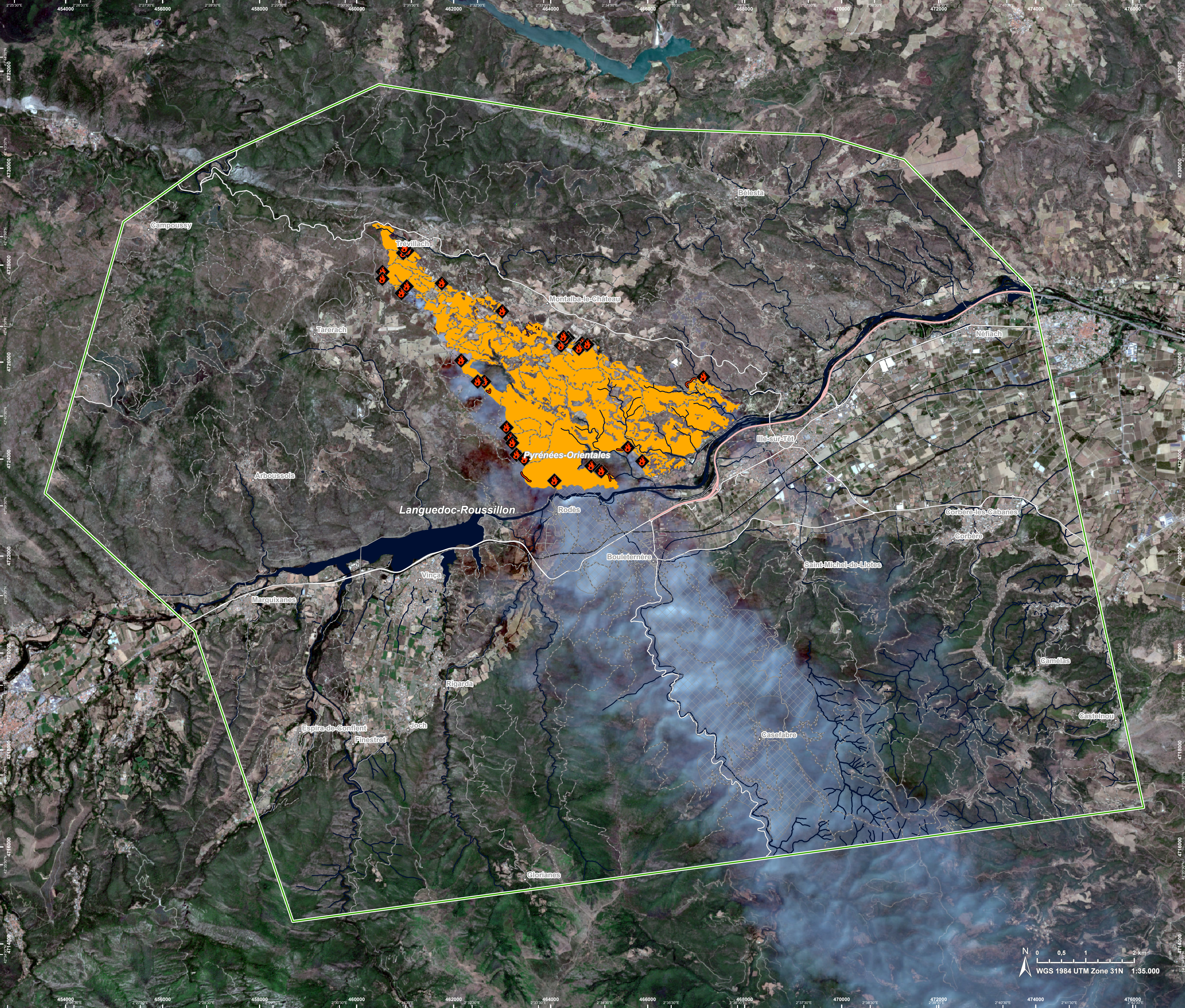

Event: On 5 July 2026 in the morning, a wildfire was reported to have affected close to the Pyrenees Regional Park, France. The event is on-going and spreading, with damage reported to affect forestry, natural vegetation and potentially nearby infrastructure. Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping is requested to provide initial rough estimation, wildfire extent and damage assessment emergency mapping.

Data sources and analysis:
Post-event image: Sentinel-2 (year of acquisition) (acquired on 05/07/2026 at 10:36 UTC, resolution 10.0 m).
This image is used as background image.
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The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image using a semi-automatic approach.
