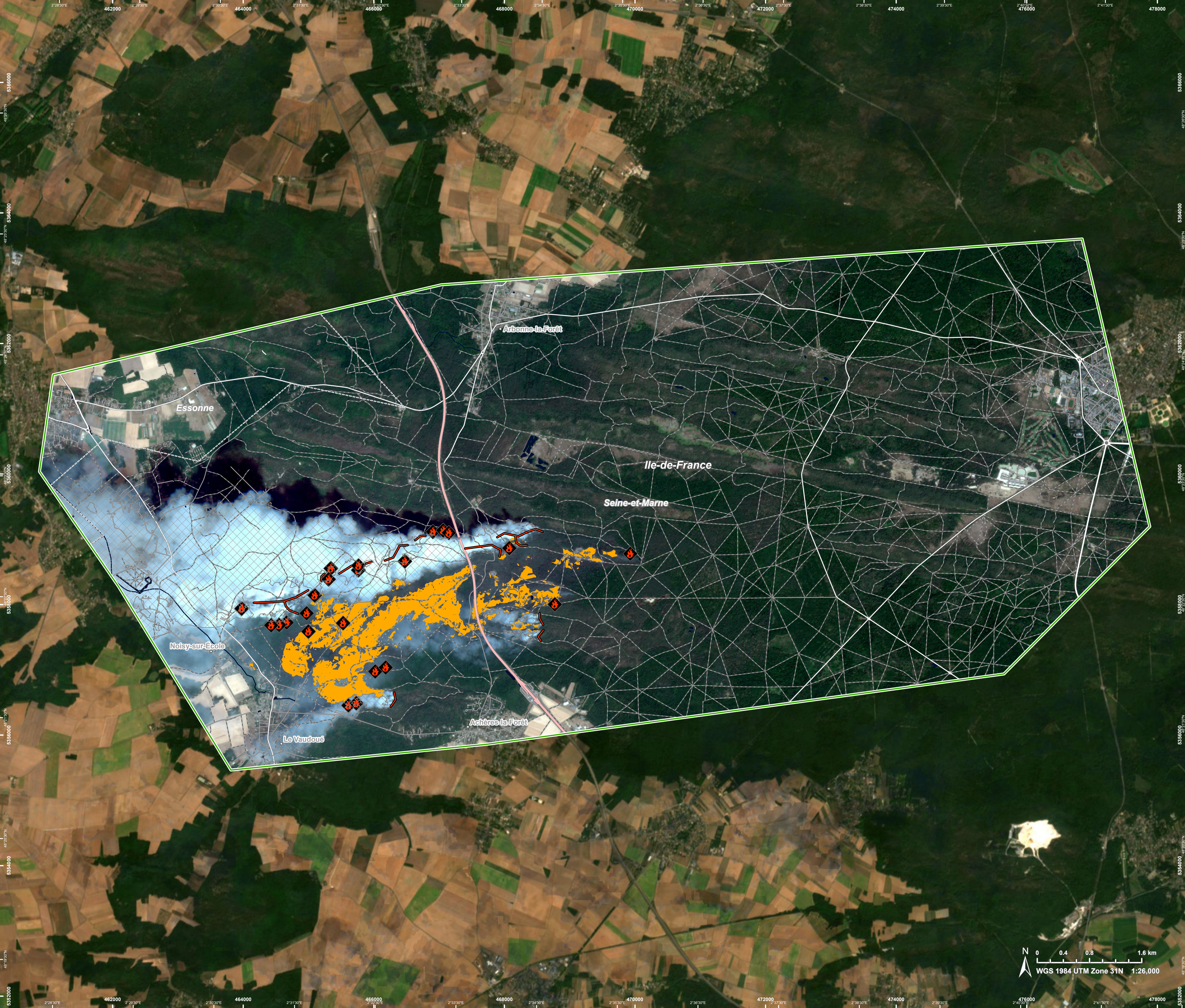
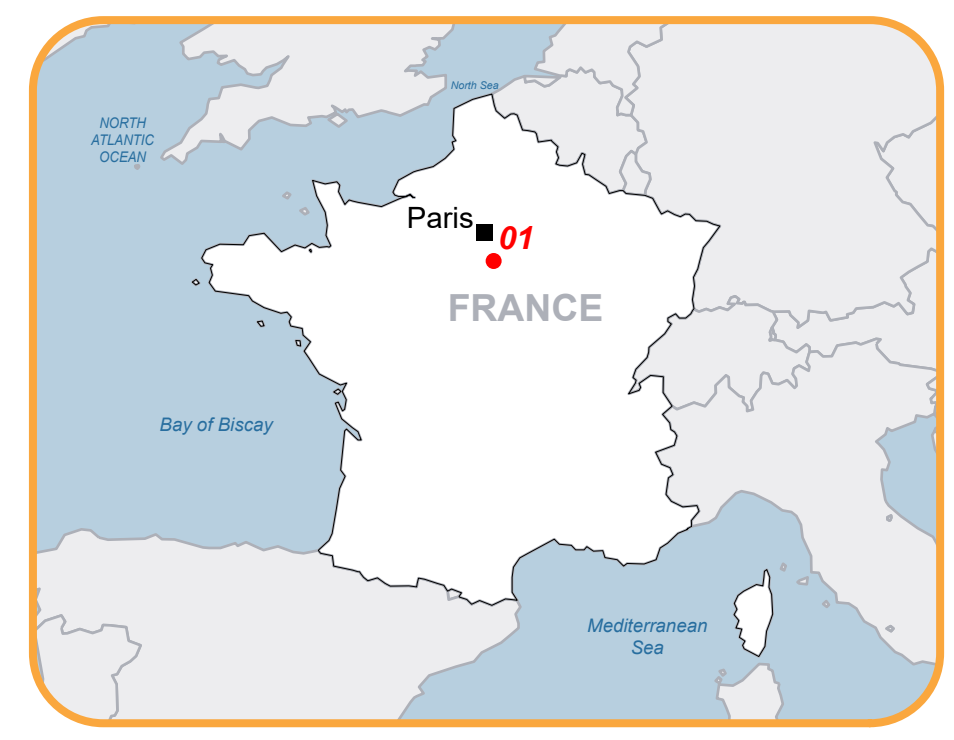

Event: On 12 July 2026, a wildfire was reported to have affected the Fontainebleau Forest, Ile-de-France, France. The event is ongoing and spreading, with damage reported to affect forestry, while the fire is threatening residential areas and critical transport infrastructure, including the A6 motorway and a nearby village. Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping is requested to provide initial rough estimation, wildfire extent and damage assessment emergency mapping.

Data sources and analysis: Post-event image: Sentinel-2 (2026) (acquired on 13/07/2026 at 10:46 UTC, resolution 10.0 m). This image is used as background image. All images are provided under COPERNICUS by the European Union and ESA, all rights reserved.

The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image using a semi-automatic approach.
