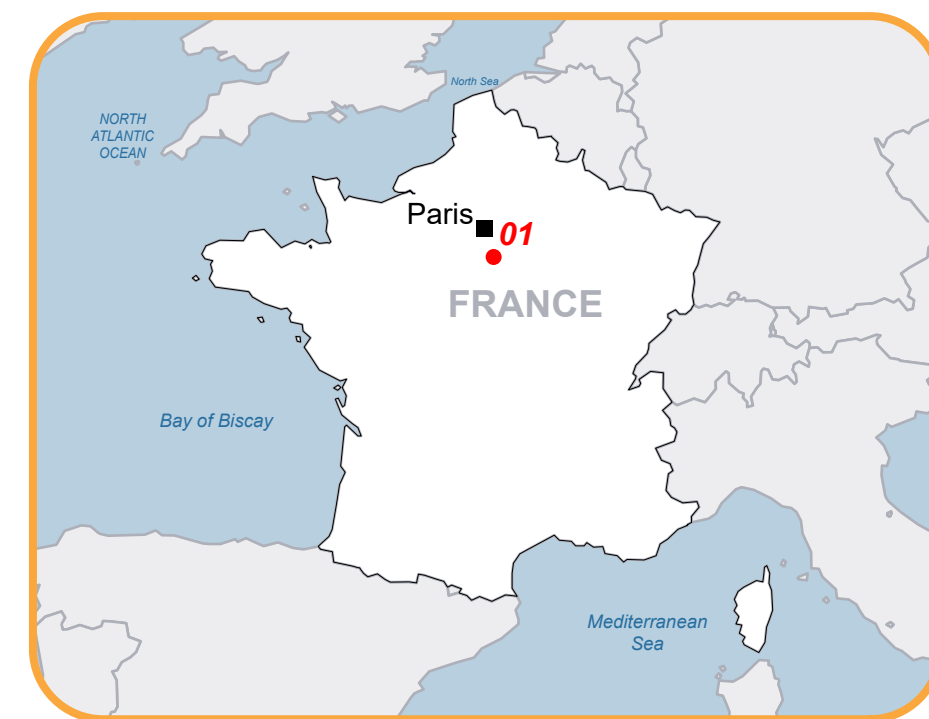

Event: On 12 July 2026, a wildfire was reported to have affected the Fontainebleau Forest, Ile-de-France, France. The event is ongoing and spreading, with damage reported to affect forestry, while the fire is threatening residential areas and critical transport infrastructure, including the A6 motorway and a nearby village. Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping is requested to provide initial rough estimation, wildfire extent and damage assessment emergency mapping.

Data sources and analysis: Pre-event image: ESRI World Imagery © DigitalGlobe (acquired on 12/08/2025 at 00:00 UTC, resolution 1.6 m). Post-event image: Legion © Vantor (2026), provided by European Space Imaging (acquired on 17/07/2026 at 07:56 UTC, resolution 1.6 m). This image is used as background image. All images are provided under COPERNICUS by the European Union and ESA, all rights reserved.

The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image using a semi-automatic approach.

The current burnt area cumulates all burnt area extents from previous post-event products.

Due to dense smoke, the burnt area delineation is not complete.
