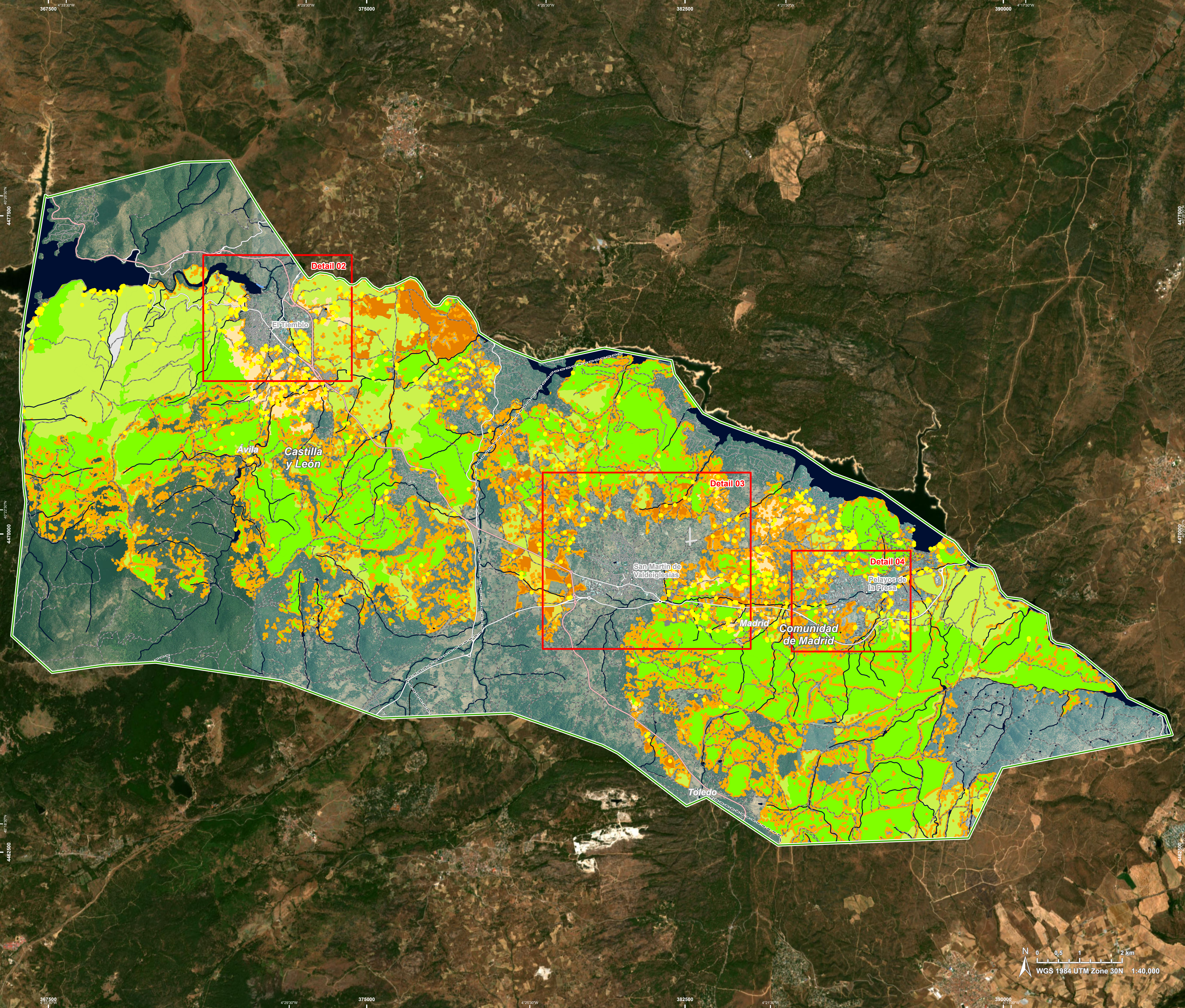

The events are on-going, with damage reported to affect forestry, protected natural areas, infrastructure, road networks, power supply and water supply, while evacuations have also taken place.

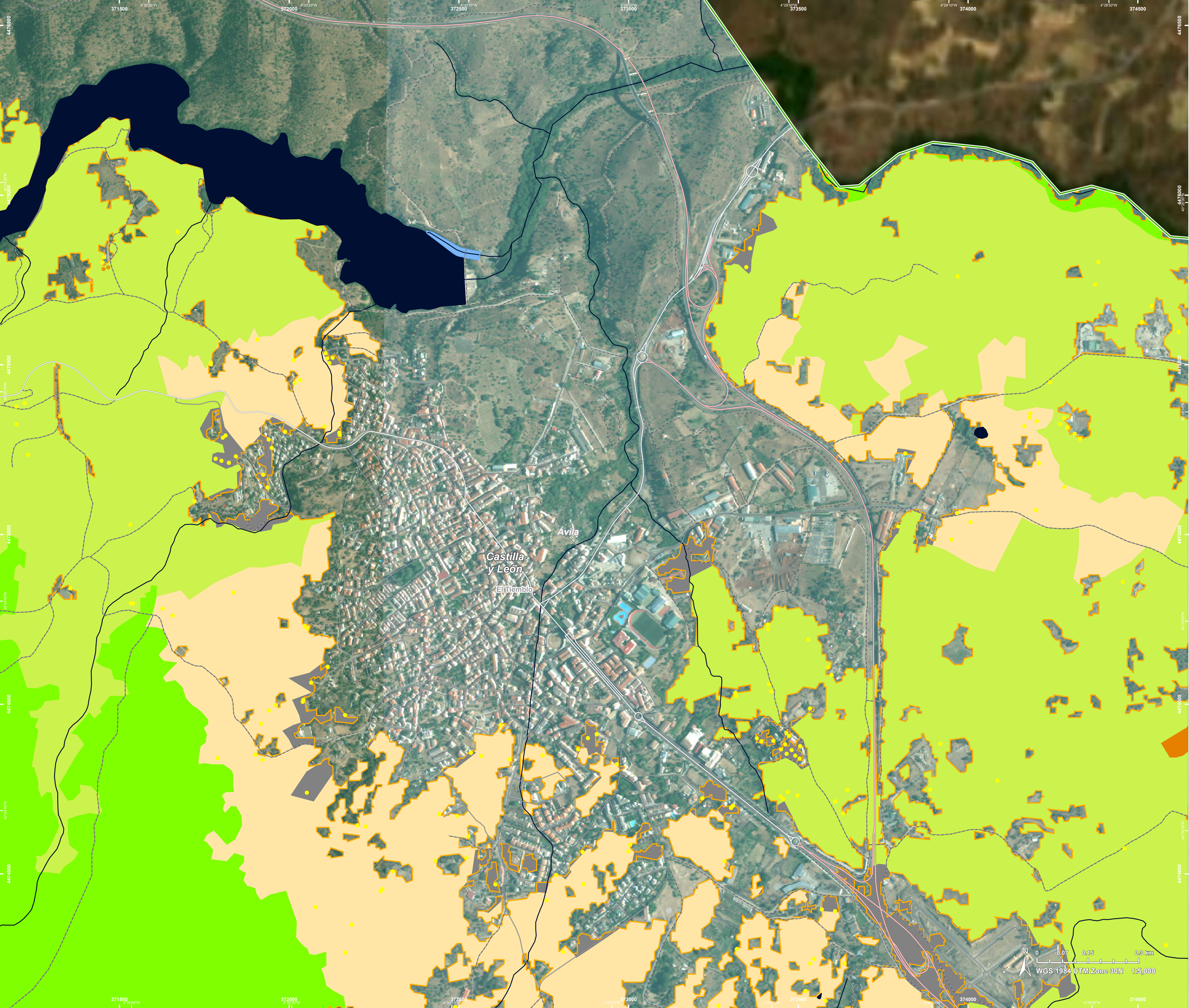
