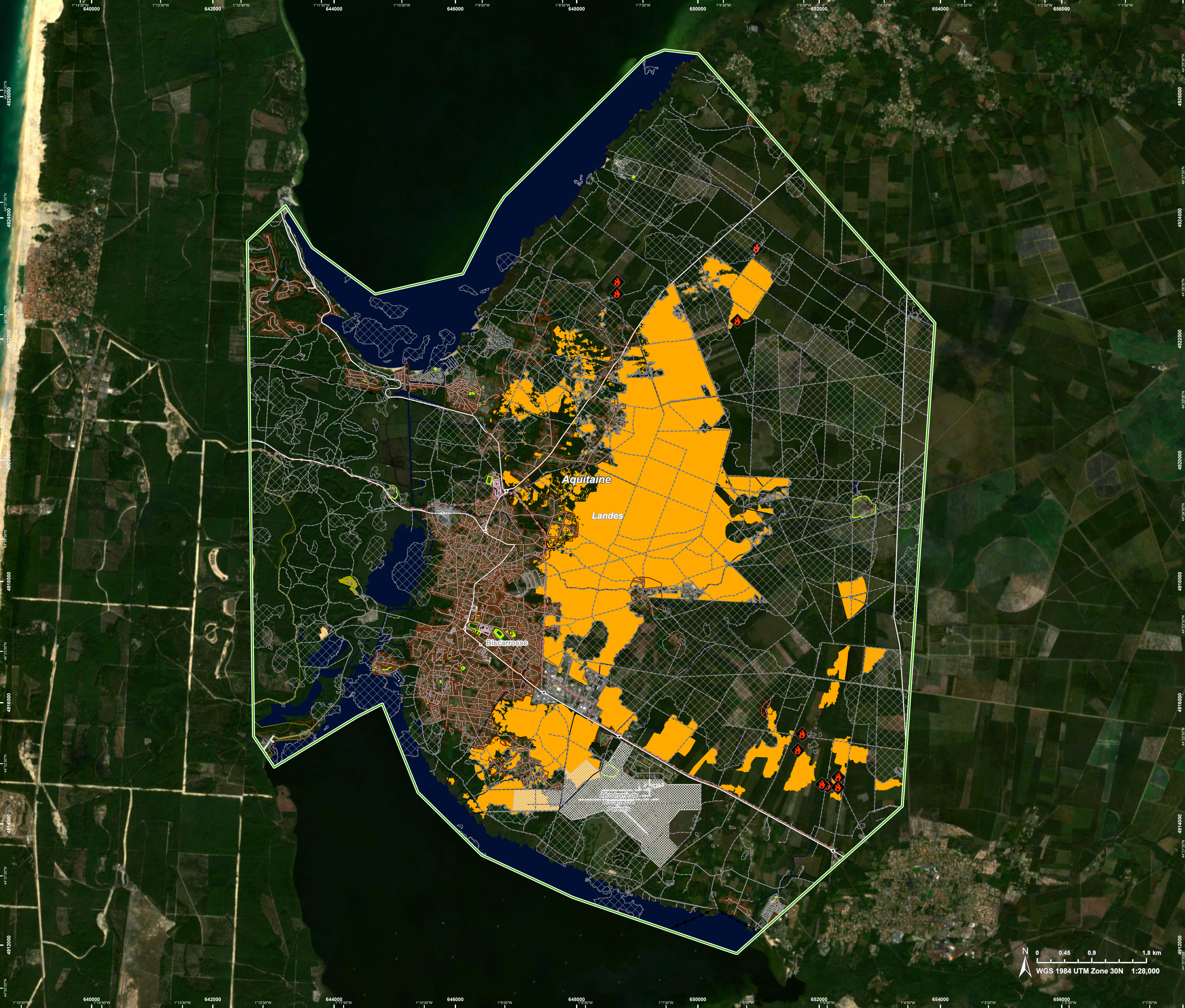

Event: On the 23 July 2026 at 14:00 UTC, a wildfire is reported to have affected in Biscarrosse, France. The event is on-going and increasing with damage forestry affecting 2200 ha and numerous homes in are potentially threatened. Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping is requested to provide initial rough estimation, wildfire extent and damage assessment emergency mapping.

Data sources and analysis: Pre-event image: Sentinel-2 (2026) (acquired on 21/07/2026 at 10:56 UTC, resolution 10.0 m). Post-event image: Sentinel-2 (2026) (acquired on 26/07/2026 at 10:56 UTC, resolution 10.0 m). Legion © Vantor (2026), provided by European Space Imaging (acquired on 26/07/2026 at 08:32 UTC, resolution 2.0 m). All images are provided under COPERNICUS by the European Union and ESA, all rights reserved.

The thematic layer has been derived from post-event satellite image using a semi-automatic approach. Due to dense clouds, the burnt area delineation is not complete.

The current burnt area cumulates all burnt area extents from previous post-event products.
