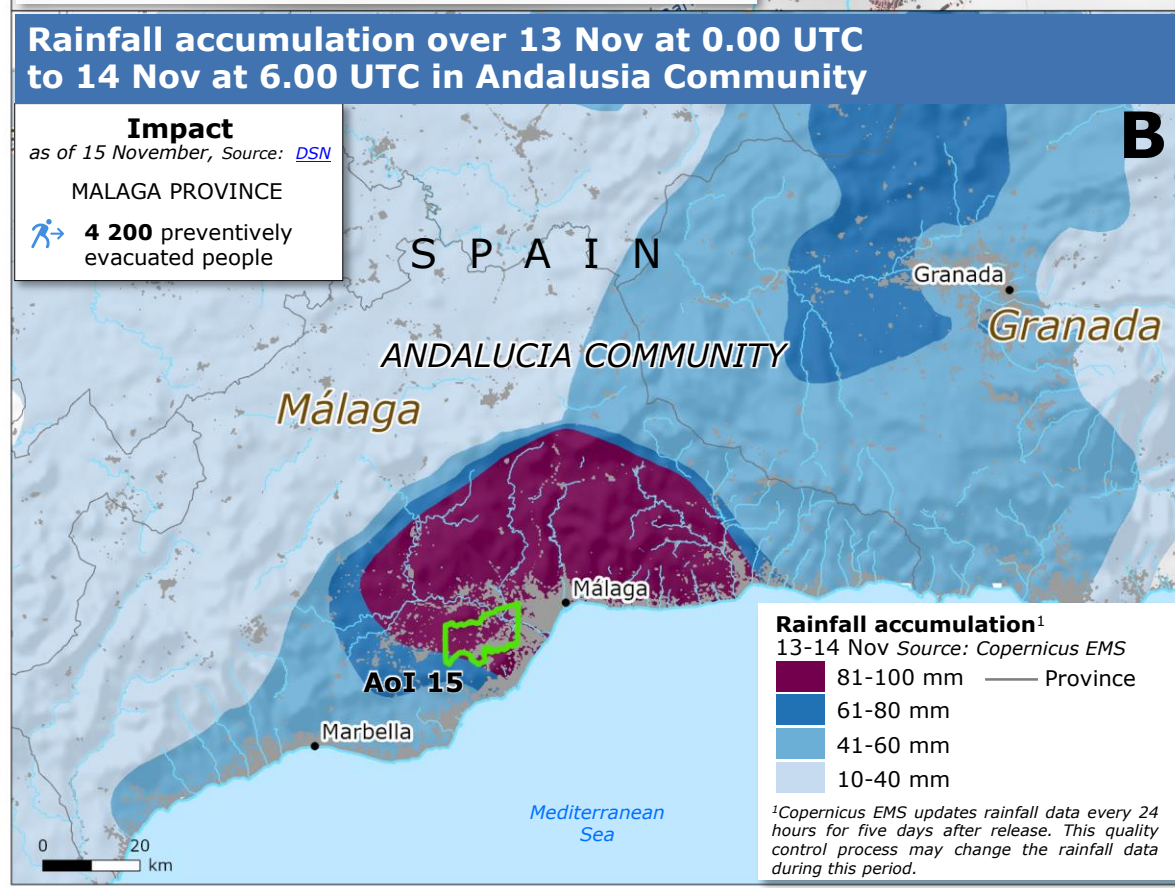
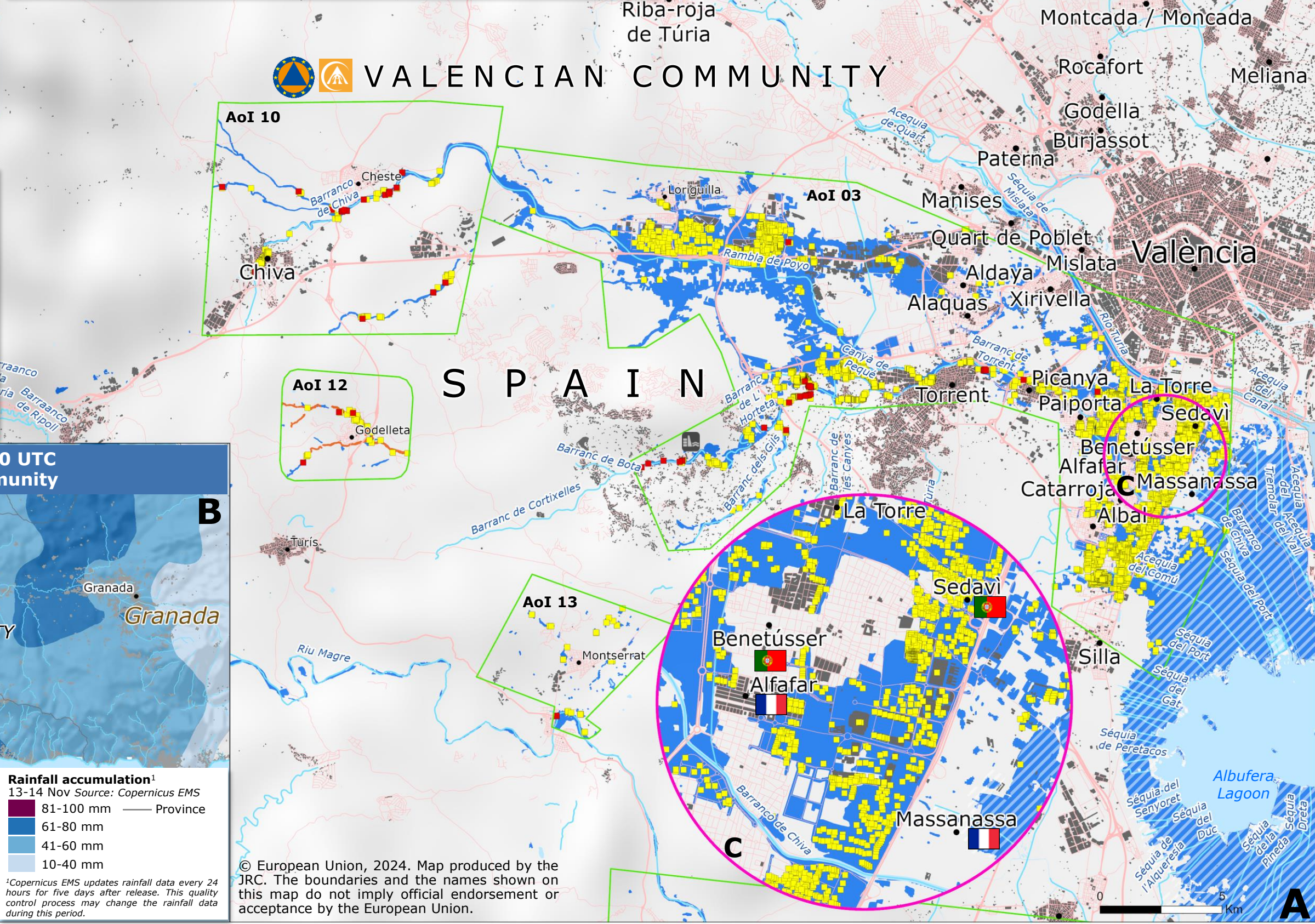
Spain activated the UCPM with a request for assistance for shelters, WASH, cleaning capacities and vehicles, waste management, and operations experts. Five Member States (BE, FR, LT, PT, RO) offered assistance. The following offers from Portugal and Spain are accepted and have arrived to Spain:

- 25 heavy machinery/vehicles
- 151 persons
- 31 pumps
- 40 maps for damage assessment and flood delineation Copernicus EMS Rapid Mapping Service ([EMSR773](#))
- 2 Liaison Officers have been deployed to Valencia
