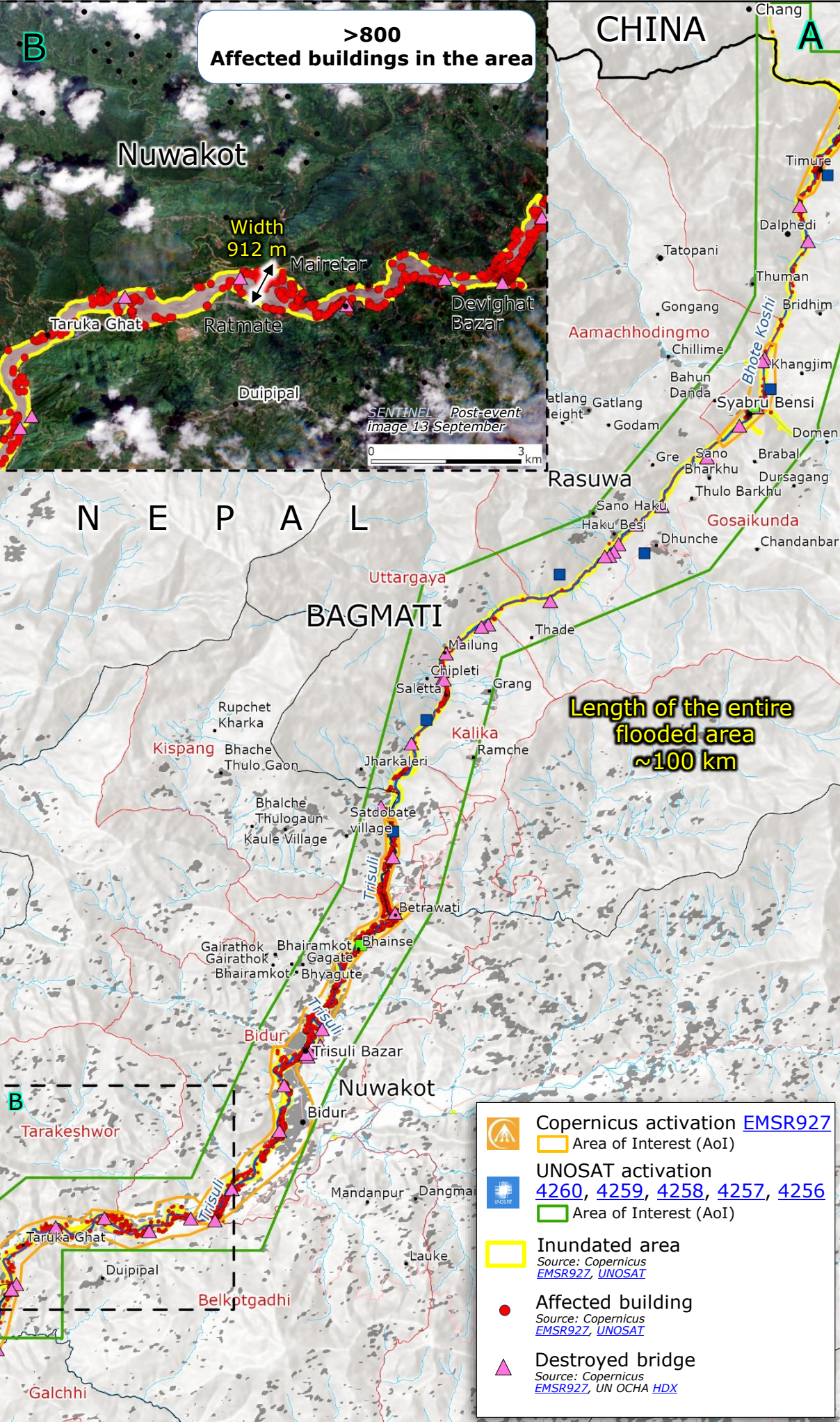




EU Response

as of 14 September at 16:00 CET

On 29 August, Nepal requested assistance via the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) for technical material, WASH, shelter and medical equipment. The following offers have been accepted:

- x>252 000 WASH items
- x>68 000 Medical and CBRN items
- x>23 000 Shelter items
- x1 Rapid Response coordinator
- x130 Protective equipment
- x3 Energy items
- x1 Operational logistics coordinator

ReliefEU capacities:

- x2 EUHAB flights
- x156.4 mt of cargo delivered, including 66mt from EU stocks
- x3 experts deployed via SBP¹ to UNDAC (x1 for mapping and x2 for coordination)

ReliefEU funding: EUR 2.5 million

Copernicus EMS (EMSR927) has been activated for damage assessment; **6 Areas of Interest** and **25 maps** have been produced.

¹ The Standby Partnerships (SBP) provides surge capacity support to United Nations (UN) Agencies through the deployment of expertise to emergencies.
