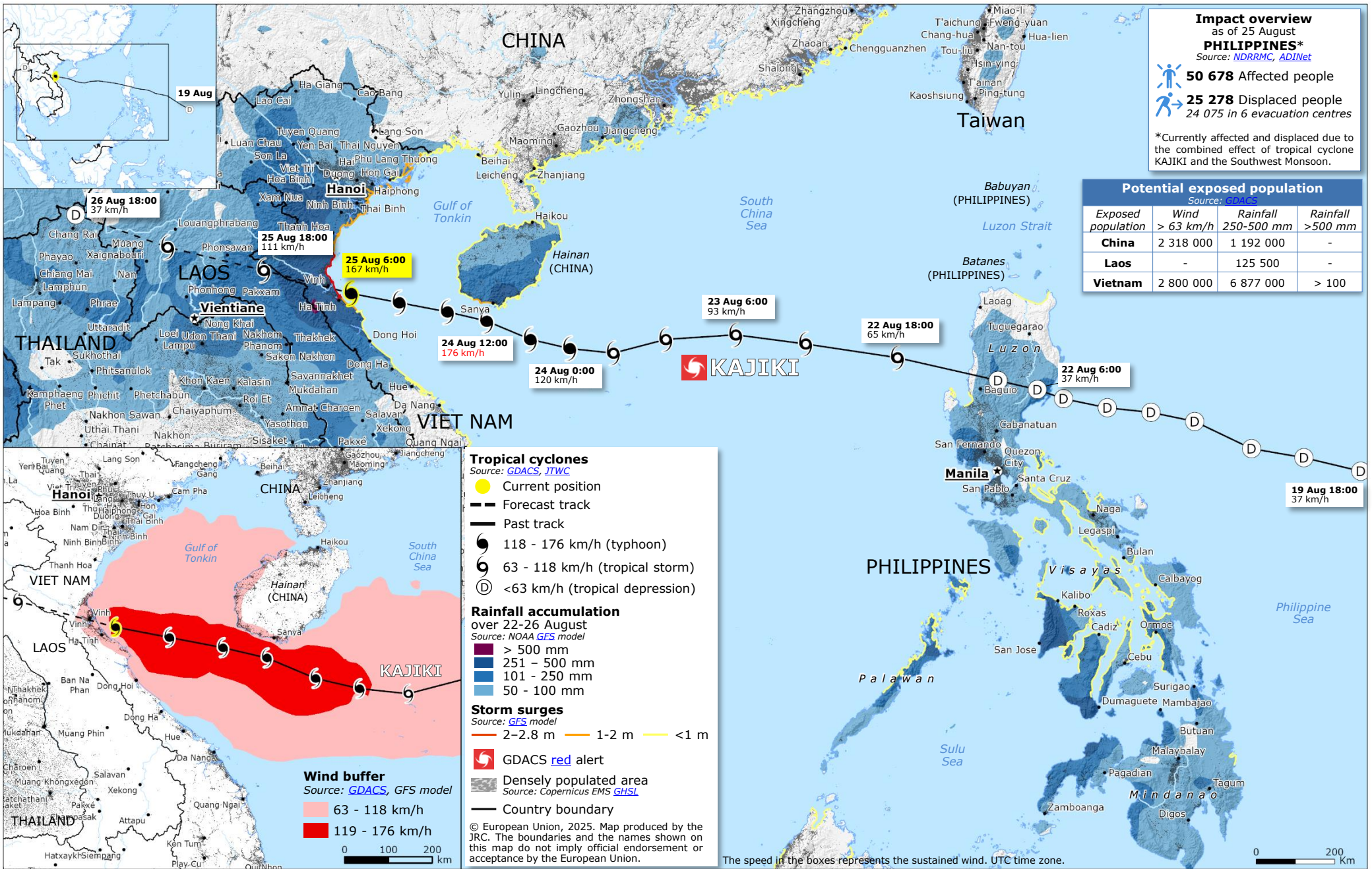


South East Asia | Tropical cyclone KAJIKI
