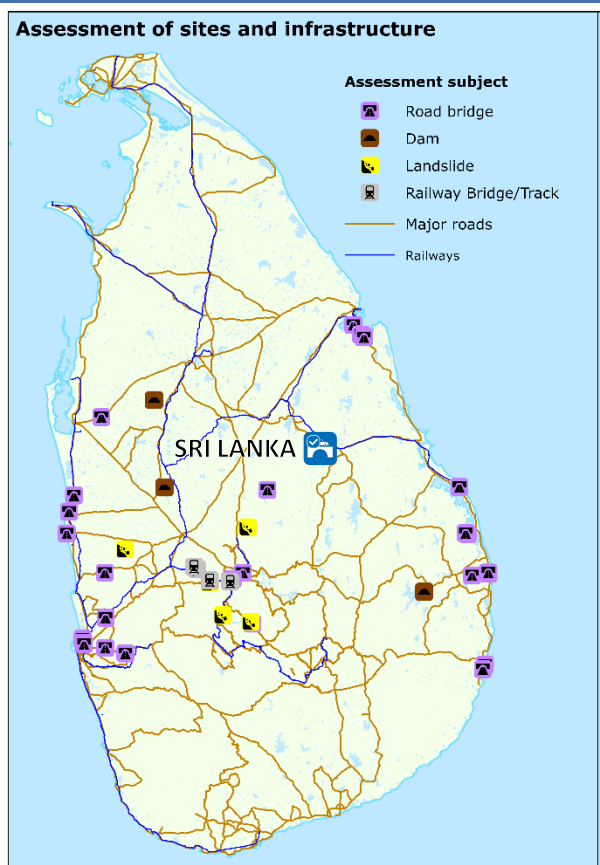


Sri Lanka | EU response to tropical storm DITWAH

as of 19 December at 14:00 UCT

- On 29 November, **Sri Lanka** requested assistance via the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM).
- Offers accepted:
 - 1 240** WASH items
 - 7 497** Shelter/NFI items
 - 1** Structural Engineering Team (10 experts)
- 44 sites assessed
14 drone inspections
