

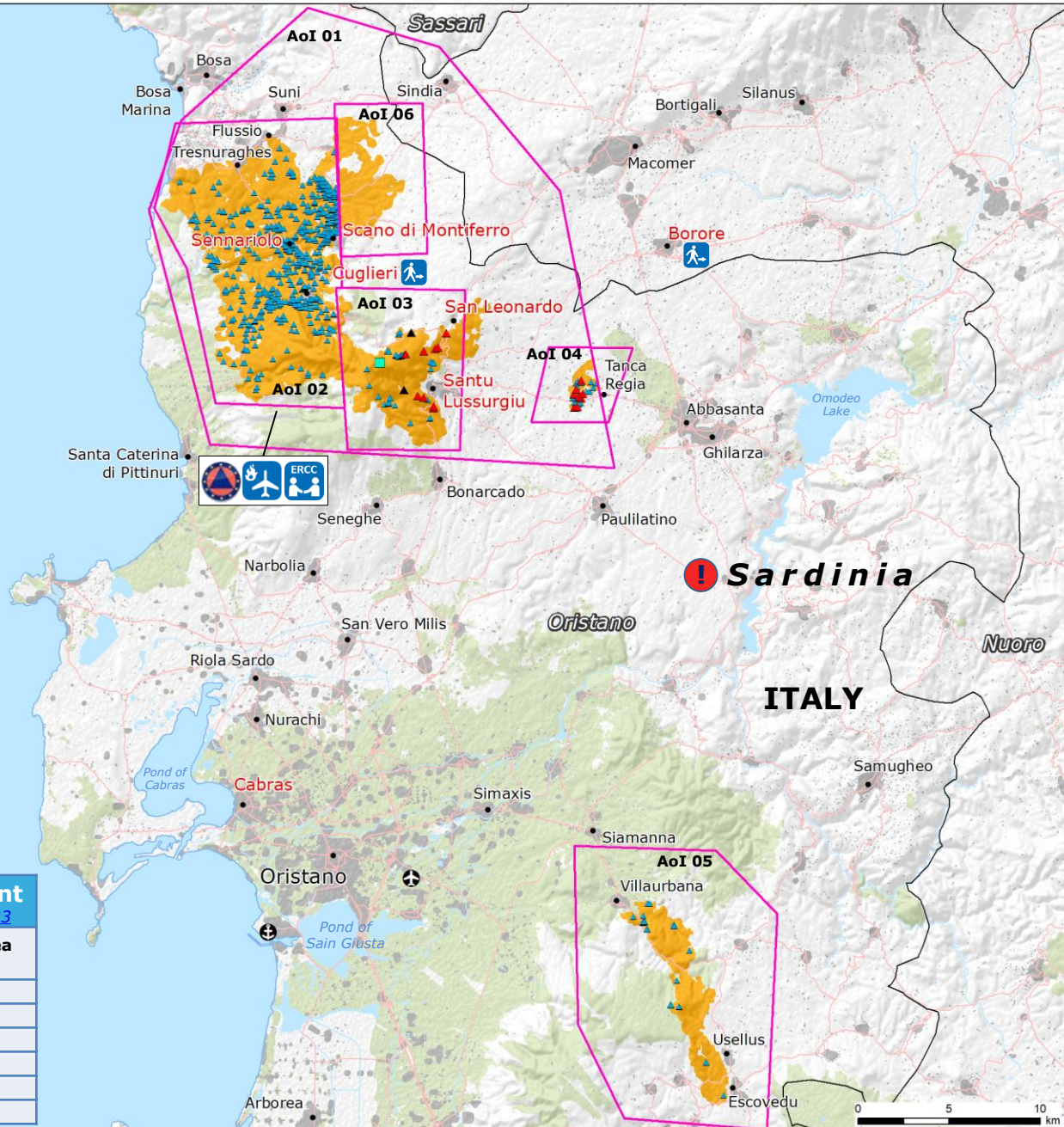
Italy (Sardinia) | Forest Fires and EU Response



580 Temporarily evacuated people on 25-26 July

The National Fire Brigades carried out 300 interventions, activating 80 mobile units. 30 teams of volunteers were deployed for extinguishing and fire recovery operations and assistance to the population.

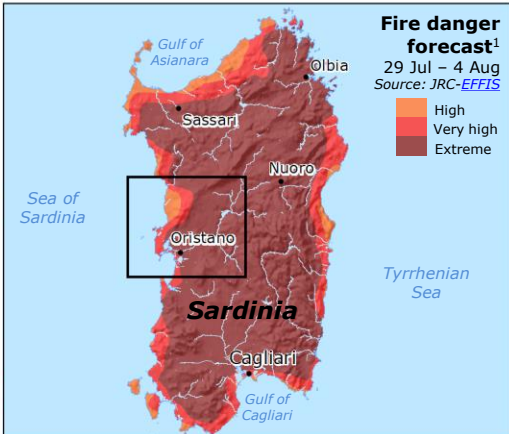


EU Response

- On 25 July, **Italy** requested assistance through the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (EUCPM) to respond to the ongoing forest fires in Sardinia.
- Aerial Forest Fire Fighting capacities from France and Greece were deployed between 26 and 28 July.
- On 29 July, Italy informed that the fire is stabilized and in the last phases of control.
