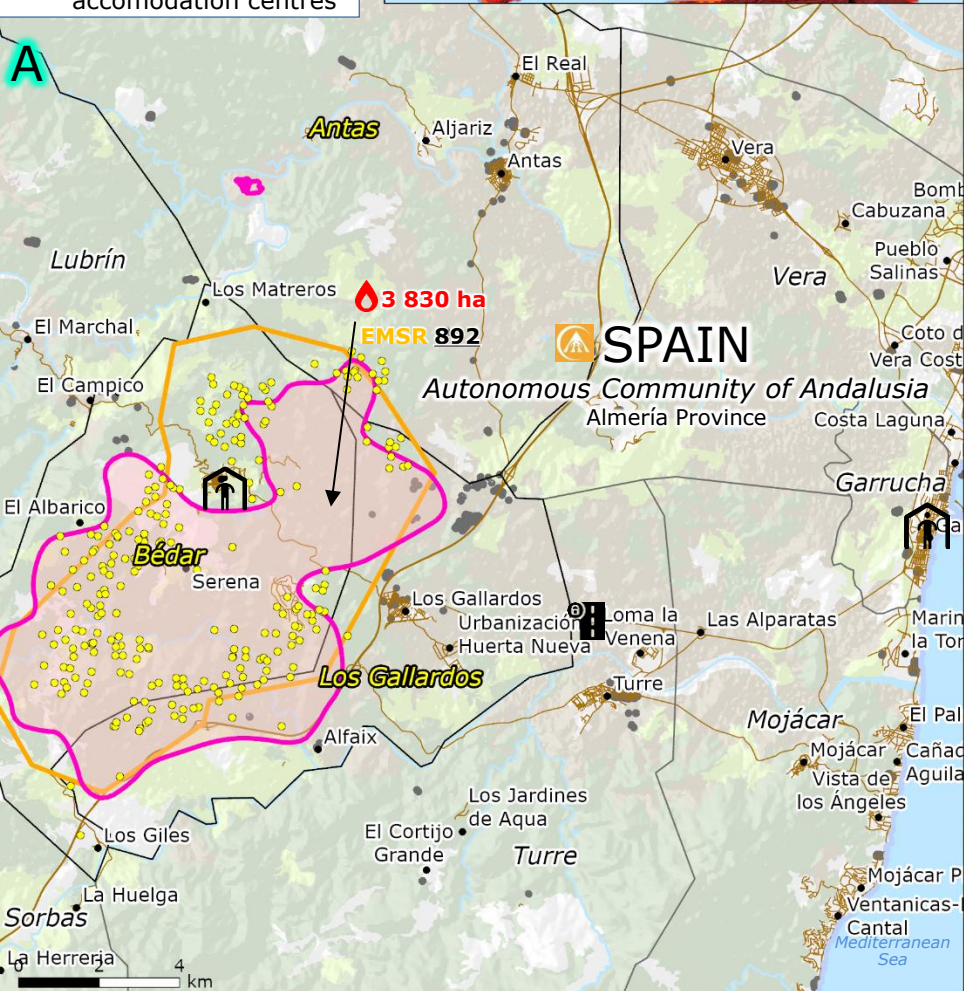
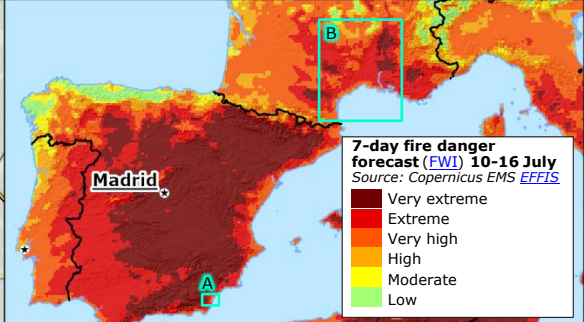


Spain, France | Wildfires and UCPM response

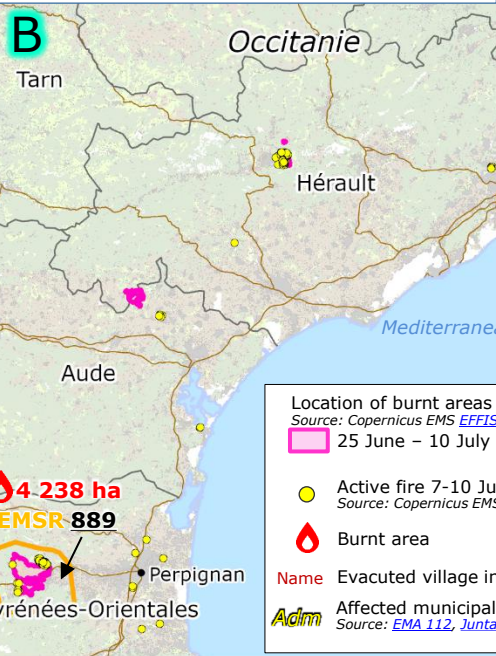
- 12 Fatalities

- > 900 Preventively evacuated people
- 2 Temporary accommodation centres

as of 10 July at 17:00 CEST

FRANCE

- France activated the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM), requesting 6 light and medium firefighting planes and 2 firefighting helicopters.
- Offered response:
 - 2 x rescEU light firefighting plane
 - 2 x rescEU light firefighting plane
 - 2 x light firefighting plane
 - 2 x rescEU medium scooping plane
 - 1 x rescEU firefighting helicopter
 - 2 x large helicopter
 - 1 x GFFF-V Prepositioned Team
 - 1 x GFFF-V Prepositioned Team
 - 1 x GFFF-V Prepositioned Team
- Copernicus Rapid Mapping service has been activated (EMSR 889, 890).
- 1 ERCC Liaison Officer was deployed from 7 to 9 July.
