



SITUATION

- Following the passage of Tropical Cyclone ENAWO, heavy rain, strong winds and storm surge have been affecting the country, causing casualties and damage. Approx. 189 mm of rain in 24 h have been recorded in Mananjary municipality and 153 mm of rain in 24 h have been recorded in Fort-Dauphin over 8-9 March.
- As of 10 March at 7.00 UTC, local media reported that the death toll has reached at least 22 people. They also reported several floods in Itasy, Analamanga, Vakinankaratra, Bongolava regions, affecting at least 2 624 people, as well as traffic disruptions throughout the affected areas.
- Over the next 48 h, moderate to locally heavy rain may still affect the country. As of 10 March 7.00 UTC, Meteo Madagascar has issued a Red Alert for heavy rains in the regions of Androy, Anosy and the districts of Befotaka, Iakora, Ampanihy, Benenitra, Vangaindrano, Midongy Atsimo and Taolagnaro, and a Red Alert for strong winds over central-western, south-western and south-eastern coastal areas.
