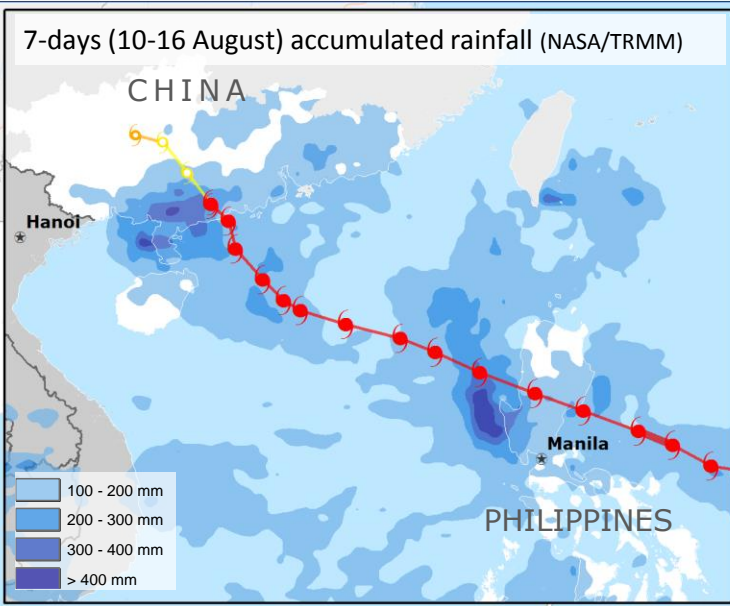
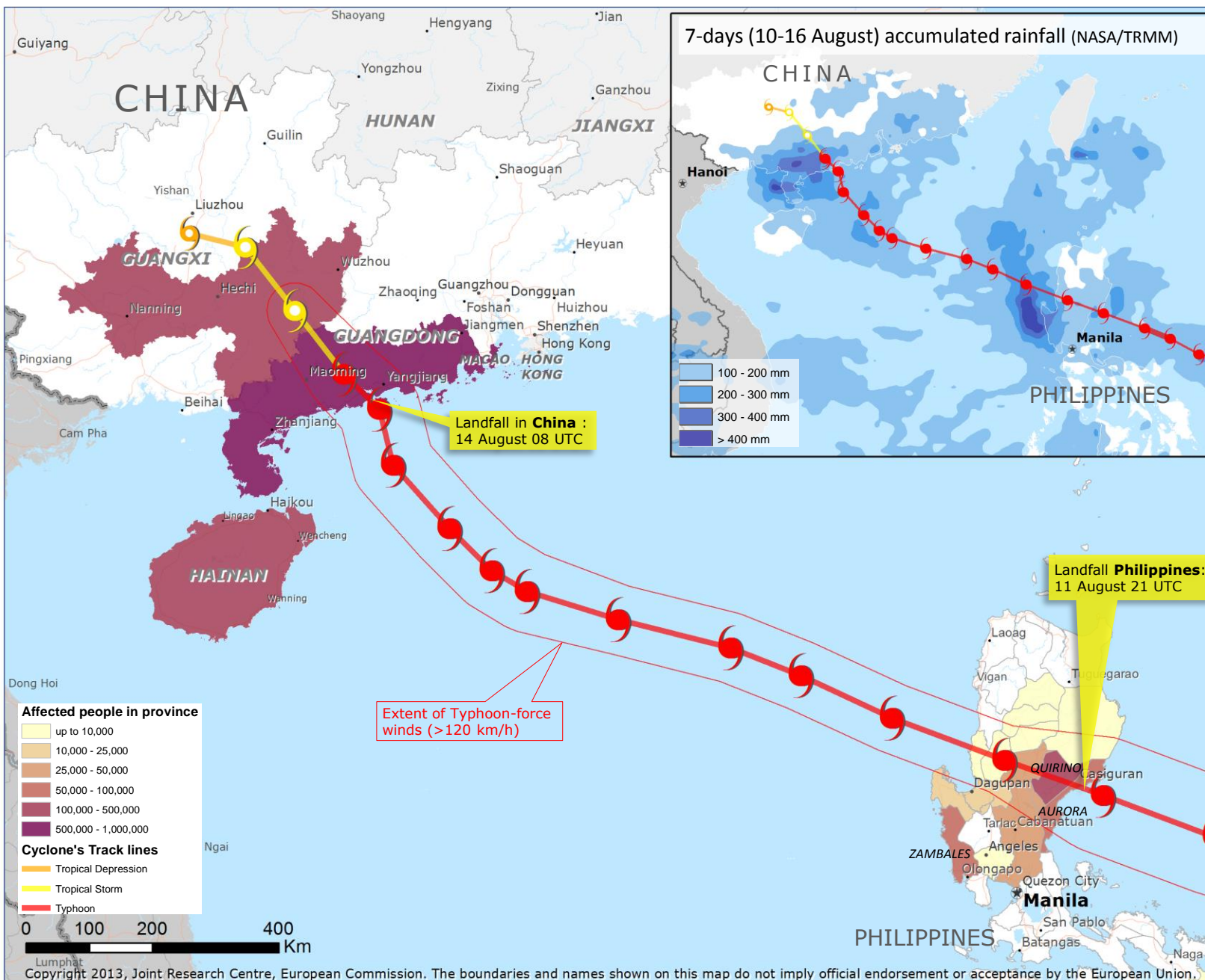


16 Aug 2013: China & Philippines – Tropical Cyclone UTOR



SITUATION

- Tropical Cyclone UTOR moved over the central/northern parts of Luzon in the Philippines on 11-12 August with Typhoon strength, then crossed the South China Sea and made a second landfall in Guangdong province of China on 14 August.
- Strong winds and heavy rainfall affected both countries, causing floods, damage to houses and crops, and casualties. Damage tolls as of 16 August for both countries are given in the Tables below. Possibly due to preventive evacuations, the death and damage toll was not as high as during previous Tropical Cyclones in the region.
